1. GENERAL INFORMATION:

1.1 Selection for admission into first year of 2 years 3 months Diploma in Pharmacy course in the Government & Private Pharmacy Colleges of the State of Orissa, approved by Pharmacy Council of India (except Women's Polytechnics, Bhubaneswar) will be conducted by the D.Pharm. Selection Committee-2011-12 (herein after called Committee) until otherwise directed by the Government.

Note: Admission to all the seats in the Pharmacy Wing, S.C.B.Medical College and 85% of total seats of all the aforesaid Private Pharmacy Colleges will be done by the Convener through counseling. Rest 15% of the seats of the Private Pharmacy Colleges will be Management quota & would be filled up by the respective management along with surplus seats left over after the Government counseling with due consideration to the Prospectus.

This list is tentative and may change subject to approval of Pharmacy Council of India. The interested candidates may contact the Convener or College concerned for further detail.

2.2. RESERVATION OF SEATS:

The reservations of seats will be as follows:

8% seats are reserved for Scheduled Castes, (SC) [by birth only and not by marriage or adoption],

12% seats are reserved for Scheduled Tribes (ST) [by birth only and not by marriage or adoption],

3% seats are reserved for Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates,

5% seats are reserved for children of Green Card holders (GC),

3% seats are reserved for children of Ex-Servicemen and defense personnel (DF)

15% seats in Private Pharmacy Colleges would be Management quota.

Scheduled Caste/Tribe persons who have migrated from their State of Origin to some other State for the purpose of seeking education, employment etc. will be deemed to be Scheduled Caste/Tribe of the State of their origin and will be entitled to derive benefits from the State of origin and not from the State to which they have migrated. (Vide Govt. of Indian letter No.BC/16014.1.82-SC & BCD/dated 22nd Feb.1985.

In Government Counseling, in case of non-availability of candidates belonging to S.C. category, S.T. candidates can be selected subject to other eligibility conditions and vice versa. In case of non-availability of candidates of SC/ST/PH/GC/DF categories, the unfilled seats will be filled up by the unreserved candidates.

The Management quota seats as well as seats remaining vacant in Private Colleges, after Government Counseling would be filled up by the management of the college concerned considering the eligibility criteria prescribed in clause 4.1 & 4.2 of the prospectus and merits of the candidate in accordance to clause 7.6 of the Prospectus.

3. PROSPECTUS AND APPLICATION FORM

Application form and prospectus can be downloaded from the **Website www.orissa.gov.in** (Click on All advertisement) or be obtained personally from the Office of the Convener, D.Pharm. Selection Committee 2011-12, Pharmacy Wing, S.C.B. Medical College, Cuttack from 17.06.2011 to 26.07.2011. There is no provision of sending blank application form through post. The last date of submission of complete form is on or before 26th July 2011 (5-00 P.M.).

4. ELIGIBILITY FOR APPLICATION

To be eligible to apply for D.Pharm. Course the applicant must -

- 4.1 Have passed 10 + 2 Science (Academic Stream) examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and/or Mathematics from C.H.S.E., Orissa or any examination equivalent to it, approved by Pharmacy Council of India (Student of Vocational/Open University are not eligible).
- 4.2 Be in between 17 to 35 years of age on 31.12.2011. *i.e.* born on or after 01.01.1977 but on or before 31.12.1994. However the upper age can be relaxed up to 3 years for candidates belonging to S.C./S.T./O.B.C./S.E.B.C. community.
- 4.3.1. Be a Native/Permanent Resident of Odisha **OR** son, daughter or spouse of permanent resident of Orissa as defined in Govt. of Orissa in Home Department Resolution No.38/reforms, dated 18.1.1949. Such candidates shall furnish certificate of Nativity/Permanent Residency of Orissa from the Tahasildar of the areas concerned. If somebody is not a native of Orissa but residing in Orissa then his/her period of residency must be mentioned on the certificate.

OR

4.3.2. Son, daughter or spouses of :

- i) Employee of Govt. of Orissa.
- ii) Defense Personnel posted in Orissa/Employee of Govt. of India working in Orissa.
- iii) Member of All India Services (Orissa Cadre) serving within/outside Orissa.
- iv) Employee of Govt. of India Undertaking/Govt. of Orissa Undertaking located in Orissa.

Such claims should be supported by certificate of service of parents or spouse from competent Authority.

4.3.3. For Oriya belonging to outlying Oriya speaking tracts (as defined by Govt. of Orissa, P. & S. Dept., Resolution No.13411 Gen. dated 8.8.69, as amended from time to time), the candidates must have Oriya as M.I.L in H.S.C. or equivalent examination. Such candidates shall furnish the certificate of authenticity of their domicile from an officer not below the rank of S.D.O. (Civil) of the locality and H.S.C. certificate showing Oriya as M.I.L.

However, the clause 4.3. will not be applicable to candidates admitted against Management quota/left over seats of Private Colleges after the Government counseling is over.

5. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

5.1 The candidates seeking admission into D.Pharm. course are to apply the “**Convener, D.Pharm. Selection Committee, Pharmacy wing , SCB Medical College, Cuttack-753007**” in the prescribed form as described in clause 3 above, along with required documents as per clause 6 below & a Bank Draft of Rs. 500/- drawn in favour of “**Convener, D.Pharm. Selection Committee 2011-12**”, payable at Cuttack.

5.2 It is the responsibility of the Candidate to see that his/her Application form, completed in all respect along with all required documents, reaches the Convener, through Registered post/Speed post/Courier service only on or before 5-00 P.M. of the last date i.e., 26.07.2011.

5.3 The office of the Convener shall have no responsibility for applications that reach late for any reason including postal delay. Such applications shall be summarily rejected and no correspondence or representation in this regard shall be entertained.

5.4 Application form must be filled in by the candidate’s own handwriting and correction made, if any, must be legibly initialed by the candidates.

5.5 Applications those are incomplete, illegible, incorrectly filled up or not accompanied by essential documents shall be summarily rejected.

6. DOCUMENTS TO BE FURNISHED ALONG WITH APPLICATION.

Clear Xerox attested copy of the following documents with full signature of the candidate should be attached to the application form. Backside contents, if any, are to be Xeroxed too.

- (i) Pass certificate of H.S.C. or equivalent examination with M.I.L. and date of birth of candidate recorded therein (if the D.O.B./subjects are not written in the H.S.Certificate but appears on the Admit Card/Mark-sheet then the same is to be enclosed). Other certificate of age such as Certificate from Headmaster/Principals of the School/College, birth certificate from hospital or municipality etc. are not acceptable.
 - (ii) Pass certificate of the qualifying examination showing the subjects studied.
 - (iii) Mark-list of the qualifying examination.
 - (iv) Conduct certificate from the Principal of the College last studied/gazetted officer.
 - (v) Caste/Tribe Certificate from the Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahasildar of the area to which the candidate belongs in case of applicant belonging to S.C./S.T. The name of the Caste/Tribe must appear in the Certificate & Schedule of Caste/Tribe of the Orissa (for S.C./S.T.) Rules, 1980; if applicable.
 - (vi) Physically Handicapped certificate issued by the Social Welfare/Panchayat Raj Department, Government of Orissa/District Social Welfare Officer in case of candidate claiming seat reserved for P.H. candidates. **(Certificate issued by Chief District Medical Officers will not be entertained)**; if applicable.
 - (vii) Green Card in the prescribed form from the Chief District Medical Officer of the concerned District in case of candidate claiming the seat reserved for children of “Green Card Holders”. **The date of birth of the beneficiary must have been mentioned clearly on this certificate. The date of birth in the Green Card should match with the date of birth mentioned in the High School certificate**; if applicable. The facility of the green card must not have been used more than once before.
 - (viii) Certificate in the prescribed form from the Station Commander/Officer Commanding/Office-in-charge, Zilla/Rajya Sainik Board in case of candidate claiming seats reserved for children of Ex-servicemen/Defense personnel; if applicable.
 - (ix) Residential/Nativity Certificate from Tahasildar.
- OR
- (x) Service Certificate of parent/spouse.
 - (x) The Bank draft for Rs. 500/- in original.
 - (xi) A self addressed stamped (Rs.22/-) envelop (Apx. Size 10 cm X 25 cm) with the correct postal address for correspondence written clearly on it.

- (xii) One copy of recent pass-port size photograph duly attested on the front side by a Group – ‘A’ or Group – ‘B’ Officer with seal should be firmly pasted at the place prescribed in the application form. The signature and the official stamp on the photograph should be placed in such a way that these extend in part to the application form. Photographs attested at the back side or loosely stapled or more than 6 months old will not be accepted.

7. SELECTION

- 7.1. Selection for admission shall be made on the basis of merit judged according to aggregate marks secured in Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics (whichever is more) in the qualifying examination. 1% mark shall be deducted from the percentage of this aggregate for each failure or dropping at the qualifying examination. (However appearing in instant examination would not liable for deduction of marks).
- 7.2.1. In case of candidates having equal marks in aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics (which ever is more) in the qualifying examination *inter se* merit shall be decided as follows :-
- 7.2.2. According to the Grand total marks (with extra optional) secured at the qualifying examination in the first attempt. In case of further tie;
- 7.2.3. According to the marks secured in biology at the qualifying examination. In case of further tie;
- 7.2.4. According to the marks secured in Chemistry at the qualifying examination.
- 7.3 The merit list of the candidates shall be published in the Notice boards of the Office of the Convener, and in website www.orissa.gov.in on 05.08.2011.
- 7.4. Allotment of seats to candidates shall be made by the Committee in the Office of the Convener, Pharmacy wing, S.C.B. Medical College, Cuttack, through counseling, *i.e.* personal appearance, taking into account the candidate’s eligibility, merit and preference for institution, subject to availability.
- 7.5. For personal appearance, the candidate will be intimated by registered post in the self addressed stamped envelope provided for correspondence and will be called in batches in order of merit as per the schedule of the counseling between 22.08.11 & 24.08.11. Failure to personally appear for the counseling with all original documents/fees in the specific date & time will liable for rejection of one’s candidature. No extension of time

would be allowed for personal appearance or submission of documents. The counseling will automatically stop, once all the seats are filled up or the candidates are exhausted.

- 7.6. After selection of candidates through counseling, any vacancy still remaining as well as the management quota can be filled up by the management of the Private Pharmacy College on or before 30.09.2011, under intimation to the Director, Medical Education and Training, Orissa, Bhubaneswar & Member-Secretary-cum-Controller of Examination, Orissa State Board of Pharmacy, Bhubaneswar, after which no admission would be made under any circumstance. The total list of candidates admitted is to be submitted to the O.S.B.P. latest by 15.10.2011 along with necessary documents for registration.

8. ADMISSION

- 8.1. Option once exercised is final and binding and no change would be allowed later, nor the money deposited would be refunded.
- 8.2. A selected candidate shall be required to produce all original documents as per intimation letter and required fee (Rs.7,500/- for Govt. College/Rs 20,000/- for Private College) in the shape of A/c Payee Bank Draft, drawn in favour of “**Convener, D.Pharm. Selection Committee 2011-12**”, payable at Cuttack, failing which the admission shall be cancelled. No cash payment will be accepted.

The college leaving certificate is to be submitted to the College concerned within 07.09.2011, failing which the admission shall stand cancelled & the fee deposited would be forfeited.

13. After admission the candidate & their Guardian are required to give declaration in form of sworn in Affidavit to the College admitted that they would not be involved in ragging. If any incidence of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution.
