## GPAT 2021 Guidelines

- When you start preparation of GPAT and NIPER. First of all give importance to the GPAT, because the preparation strategy is different for GPAT and NIPER.
- Whereas GPAT concentrate on subject knowledge deeply and it is somewhat time taking to answer the questions
- When compare to the NIPER in which concentrate only on basics of subject especially in organic and stereo chemistry and analytical chemistry.
- When you qualified in GPAT then only you will be eligible for NIPER.
- First divide all subjects from simple to difficulty and according to their weight age in entrance exam.
- According to my opinion I will give an idea First start with order 1. Pharmacognosy 2. Pharmacology 3. Analysis 4. Pharmaceutical calculations 5. Pharmaceutical Jurisprudence 6. Biochemistry, Microbiology, Biotechnology 7. Pharmaceutics- physical pharmacy, Unit operations, Bio pharmaceutics, Dispensing and clinical pharmacy 8. Medicinal Chemistry.

- **GPAT EXAM FORMAT & PATTERN**
  - Test Paper Contain Total 125 MCQ.
  - Each right answer having 4 marks.
  - Total marks 500.
  - Time limit: 180 Min •
  - Negative marking 1 mark for each wrong answer.
  - No negative marking for questions which are not attempted.
- **Strategy for Qualify GPAT –**
  - Total 125 MCQ are there in exam.
  - To qualify GPAT exam it is enough to attempt 70 to 80 MCQ.
  - Last three years Average cutoff to Qualify exam was for open & OBC: 115 to 125 Marks out of 500. • For SC & ST: 90 to 100 Marks out of 500.
  - If u attempt 80 MCQ from that around 50 MCQ right & around 30 MCQ wrong your score will be 170/500.
  - If u attempt 70 MCQ from that around 40 MCQ right & around 30 MCQ wrong your score Will be 130/500.
  - Above 130 is the safe score to qualify GPAT.
  - But try to score above 150 for Higher All India Rank.

➤ **Strategy for Being GPAT Topper–**

- Must have to attempt 90 to 100 MCQ • 60 to 70 MCQ must be correct • so your score will be B/W 200 to 250 • All India Rank will be in top 10 or 100 • If u attempt more MCQ WITH confidence then more chance to qualify GPAT exam.

➤ **EXPERT REVIEW BY GPAT TOPPER**

- GPAT includes mostly all the 4 year syllabus of B.pharma, which is very vast so one must start preparing for it at least 7 month before the exam.
- A thorough and basic knowledge of pharmacy will make it easier to crack GPAT.
- One should start the preparation with main and hard subjects like Pharmacology, Pharmaceutics & pharmacognosy.
- Make a routine & do each subject every day.
- Never do one subject whole day.
- When you start preparing for GPAT, make sure you read everything thoroughly so that you have a good concept of it. Never rush and try to finish it quickly, because starting time is the best time for gaining the concept.
- Also start solving at least 50 questions per day; it will help you to evaluate yourself.
- Ever leave easy subjects like jurisprudence, dispensing, calculation etc.
- As there are very direct question from them and if you have read them it will help you score marks.
- Now days questions from anatomy & physiology are also coming, so do it also.
- Maximum 2 days are enough for it.
- Last one month is very important so revise whole syllabus carefully.
- Keep the subject which you have problem remembering it for the last 2 days.
- Remember not to study anything new in last 15 days.
- Just revise all you have studied.
- Never get anxious or scared by others preparation. Only focus on yourself.
- Make notes while studying, it comes very handy in last days.
- Do last year question papers?
- Lastly do not panic before the exam, just relax, open your mind & give the exam.
